PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA

The Radiologic Technology program's 5-year program completion rate, credentialing pass rate, and job placement rate may also be viewed on the Joint review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology website www.jrcert.org. The program tracks student learning outcomes and program effectiveness using a variety of tools. The following data is gathered from program statistics, and surveys that are sent to both graduates and their employers 12 months after graduation.

Program Completion Rate

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the 24 month program within 150% of the stated program length (36 months).

Job Placement Rate

Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in radiography within twelve months of graduates compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

Not actively seeking employment is defined by JRCERT as:

- Graduate fails to communicate with program regarding employment after multiple attempts, **OR**
- Graduate unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, **OR**
- Graduate unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, **OR**
- Graduate is continuing education, **OR**
- Graduate is on active military duty, **OR**
