



Financial Assistance Program – Plain Language Summary

Grady Health System and Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta - Hughes Spalding offers discounted care under a Financial Assistance Program to qualified individuals for emergency and medically necessary services.

Eligible patients will not be charged more than amounts generally billed to those with insurance.

Who’s Eligible?

The amount of financial assistance you may receive depends on your income, family size and county of residence. Patients with a family income at 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) or below may be eligible for a discount.

What Services are Covered?

Emergency and medically necessary care provided by Grady Health System and Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta – Hughes Spalding. The program covers services provided by all physicians and advance practice providers associated with your care. The program does not cover cosmetic services.

How to Apply?

You will need to provide the following:

- Government Issued ID
- Proof of county of residence
 - Lease contract or rent receipt
 - Utility/Cable bill
- Proof of Income
 - Current pay stub
 - Social Security letter
 - Unemployment claim
- Proof of Family Size
 - Most recent tax return
 - Dependent’s birth certificates
