



**Grady Health System Schools of Radiation and Imaging Technologies
and Saint Joseph's College of Maine
Transfer Agreement**

This Agreement provides transfer admission opportunities for academically qualified students and graduates of Grady Health System Schools of Radiation and Imaging Technologies (Grady Health) who are interested in completing their degrees through Saint Joseph's College of Maine's Online (SJC). Please see the attached for a list of eligible programs and approved transfer maps/course equivalencies.

Terms of Agreement:

- I. SJC will accept for admission a degree candidate who has earned a grade point average of 2.0 or better (based on a 4.0 scale) into the appropriate online bachelor's degree program upon confirmation of official transcripts. The student must also meet any additional specific admission and enrollment standards/requirements for their desired program at SJC.
- II. Students accepted at SJC will receive academic credit for all college-level courses that were successfully completed with a letter grade of C or better, are deemed comparable to current SJC courses, and fit within their degree program at SJC. Non-credit or remedial courses will not be accepted for transfer credit and/or graduation requirements. All transcripts will be reviewed on an individual basis at the time of application.
- III. If a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper-level course due to a lack of the appropriate introductory course(s), any necessary prerequisite course(s) will be required.
- IV. Prerequisite and/or general education courses required for the Bachelor's degree may be transferred from other accredited institutions, but 25% of the identified course requirements must be completed at SJC. SJC will accept a maximum of 90 transfer credits.

V. Students pursuing a Radiologic Science Administration degree at SJC with the intention of completing their radiography technical training at Grady Health can complete Grady Health's required pre-requisite courses through SJC. However, doing so does not guarantee admission to Grady Health's program.

VI. Students pursuing a Radiologic Science Administration degree at SJC must transfer in radiography training credits in order for the degree to be conferred. The Radiologic Technology program at Grady Health has been reviewed and approved by SJC to transfer into SJC's Radiologic Science Administration programs, provided minimum grades are met and SJC receives official transcripts from Grady Health.

VII. At the undergraduate level, courses must be completed with a C or better in order to be considered for transfer.

VIII. Course equivalencies noted in this agreement are based on the 2022-2023 catalog year. This agreement may be reviewed annually and revised by mutual consent.

IX. Both Grady Health and SJC agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising to the public for the purpose of marketing the programs described herein.


X. Grady Health agrees to promote this partnership and provide informational materials to their current and prospective students, as well as graduates. SJC will reciprocate by including the partnership on their webpage.

Grady Health and SJC, recognizing the importance of providing a seamless coordination process for students, hereby enter into a Transfer Agreement. We, the undersigned, as the representatives of Grady Health and SJC, hereby demonstrate our commitment to full implementation of the agreement.
