The Diagnostic Medical Sonography program's completion rates, credentialing success rates, job placement rates, and test taker rates are outlined below. This includes the three (3) most recent graduating classes (cohorts) that have been graduated for at least 1 year. The program tracks student learning outcomes and program effectiveness within 12 months post-graduation using a variety of tools. The following data is gathered from program statistics from ARDMS, and surveys that are sent to both graduates and their employers.
