DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL SONOGRAPHY PROGRAM PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA

The Diagnostic Medical Sonography program's 6-year program completion rates, credentialing pass rates, and job placement rates are outlined below. This includes the five (5) most recent graduating classes that have been graduated for at least 1 year. The program tracks student learning outcomes and program effectiveness within 12 months post-graduation using a variety of tools. The following data is gathered from program statistics from ARDMS, and surveys that are sent to both graduates and their employers.
