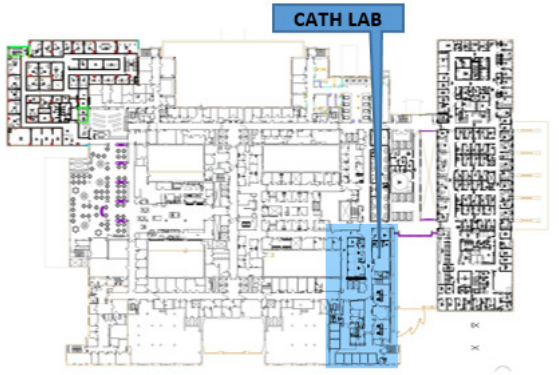

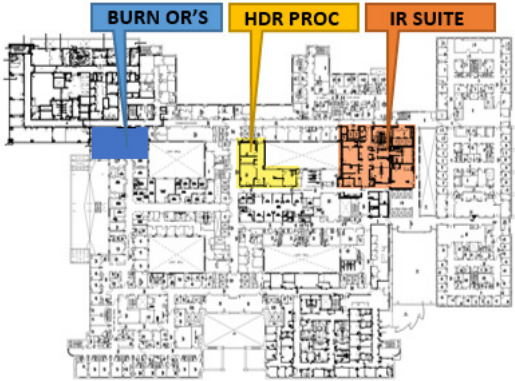

CATH Lab Suite – Second Floor

Currently Grady staff's 3 CATH Labs, built in the 1990's. The design of the existing CATH LAB Suite includes a group of three LAB's within a sterile suite. The LAB's range in size from 305 SF to 515 SF. Over the 35 year use of the CATH Lab space has served the clinical need, but the current limitations per room and an inability to advance technology will warrant a future renovation. The rooms will need to be right-sized to accommodate a future renovation, but the current capacity of three rooms meets the clinical need.

Burn OR Suite – Third Floor

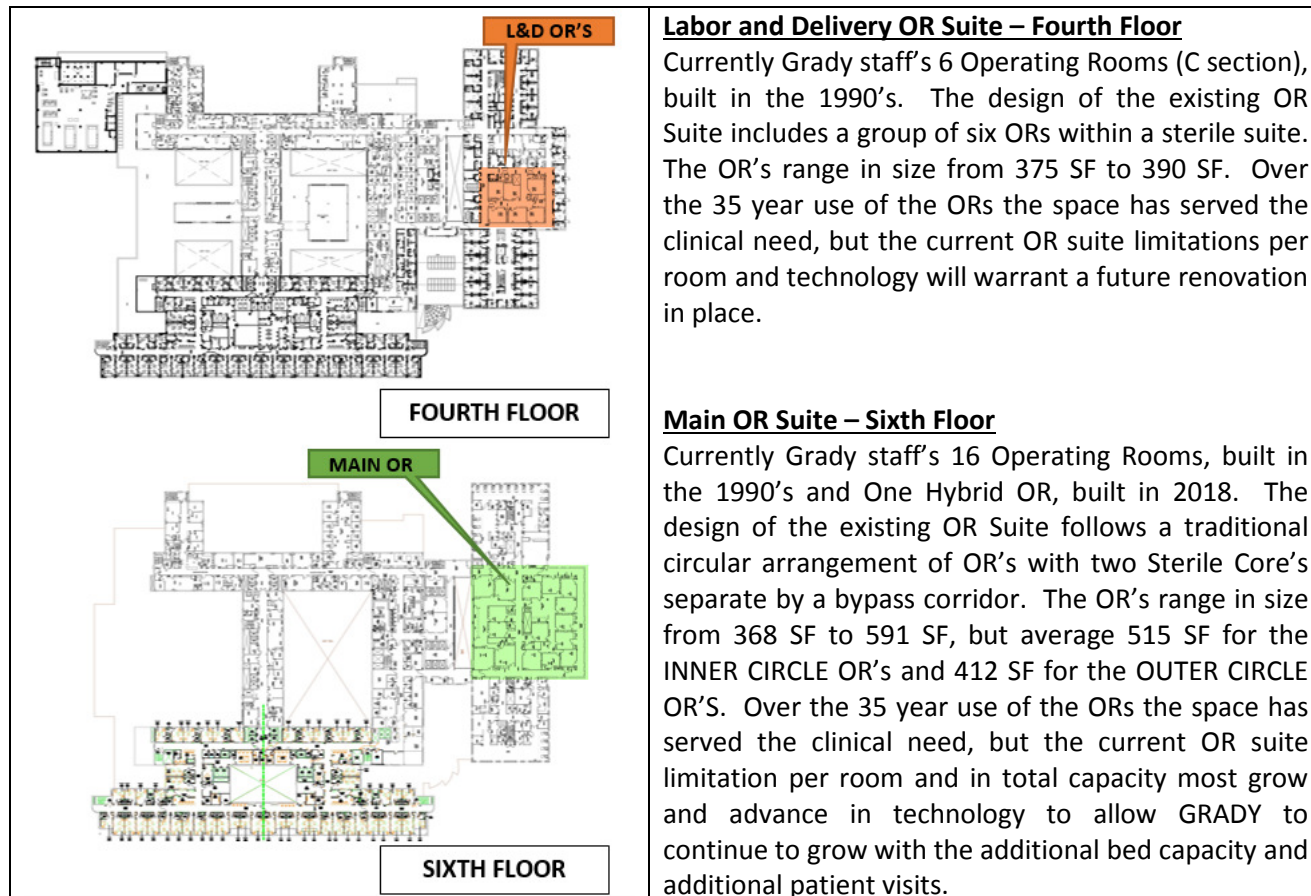
Currently Grady utilizes the main OR for burn procedures. The design of the BURN Expansion includes a new OR Suite with two new OR's on the third floor. The new OR Suite will be immediately adjacent to the Burn Center and includes to 400 SF operating rooms.

HDR Suite – Third Floor

A recent upgrade in facilities built out a new procedural suite with two special procedure rooms on the third floor, ranging in size from 325 SF to 420 SF. This space serves the current clinical need.

IR Suite – Third Floor

A recent upgrade in facilities built out a new procedural suite with two IR procedure rooms on the third floor, approximately 450 SF in size. The upgrade also set the boundary for a third new IR procedural suite, to be built-out next year. This space serves the current clinical need, but will need to grow with the service line.



Labor and Delivery OR Suite – Fourth Floor

Currently Grady staff’s 6 Operating Rooms (C section), built in the 1990’s. The design of the existing OR Suite includes a group of six ORs within a sterile suite. The OR’s range in size from 375 SF to 390 SF. Over the 35 year use of the ORs the space has served the clinical need, but the current OR suite limitations per room and technology will warrant a future renovation in place.

Main OR Suite – Sixth Floor

Currently Grady staff’s 16 Operating Rooms, built in the 1990’s and One Hybrid OR, built in 2018. The design of the existing OR Suite follows a traditional circular arrangement of OR’s with two Sterile Core’s separate by a bypass corridor. The OR’s range in size from 368 SF to 591 SF, but average 515 SF for the INNER CIRCLE OR’s and 412 SF for the OUTER CIRCLE OR’S. Over the 35 year use of the ORs the space has served the clinical need, but the current OR suite limitation per room and in total capacity most grow and advance in technology to allow GRADY to continue to grow with the additional bed capacity and additional patient visits.

Phase 2 - OR CEILING SYSTEMS

Design and build a ceiling, light, and boom replacement.

All firms and/or manufacturers planning to submit a proposal must be pre-qualified or submit qualifications for consideration. To become qualified, please submit a qualifications package meeting the following requirements:

- List of three to five healthcare Inpatient, Critical/Intensive Care projects of similar size and scale.
- Brief narrative of each of the referenced projects.
- Organization chart of your team.

- One page CV or resume of each team member.
