RADIATION THERAPY PROGRAM
PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA**

The Radiation Therapy program's 5-year program completion rate, credentialing pass rate, and job placement rate may also be viewed on the Joint review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology website www.jrcert.org. The program tracks student learning outcomes and program effectiveness using a variety of tools. The following data is gathered from program statistics, and surveys that are sent to both graduates and their employers 12 months after graduation.

Program Completion Rate

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the 12 month program within 150% of the stated program length (within 18 months).

2015	78%	7 of 9 students completed the program; 1 voluntary withdrawal; 1 termination
2016	100%	12 of 12 students completed the program
2017	100%	9 of 9 students completed the program
2018	91%	10 of 11 students completed the program; 1 withdrawal
2019	100%	8 of 8 students completed the program
5-year average	94%	46 of 49 students have completed the program

Credentialing Pass Rate

Five-year credentialing pass rate (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiation Therapy exam) of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within six months of graduation.

2015	86%	81	6 of 7 students passed on the 1 st attempt
2016	83%	82	10 of 12 students passed on the 1 st attempt
2017	100%	85	7 of 7 students passed on the 1 st attempt; 2 students did not take exam
2018	100%	83	9 of 9 students passed on 1 st attempt; 1 student did not take exam
2019	100%	79	8 of 8 students passed on 1 st attempt
5-year average	94%	82	40 of 43 students passed on 1st attempt.

Job Placement Rate

Not actively seeking employment is defined by JRCERT as:

- Graduate fails to communicate with program regarding employment after multiple attempts.
- Graduate unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation.
- Graduate unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours.
- Graduate is continuing education.
- Graduate is on active military duty.

Year	Percent job placement	Number of students
2015	86%	6 of 7 students graduates seeking employment had jobs within 12 months of graduation
2016	86%	6 of 7 actively pursuing employment had jobs within 12 months. 1 student continued education. 4 students did not communicate with the program regarding employment status.
2017	100%	6 out of 6 graduates actively pursuing had job within 12 months. 1 student continued education. 2 students did not take the certification exam.
2018	100%	9 out of 9 graduates actively pursuing had job within 12 months.
2019	100%	9 out of 9 graduates actively pursuing had job within 12 months.
5-year average	94%	36 out of 38 graduates actively pursuing had job within 12 months.
